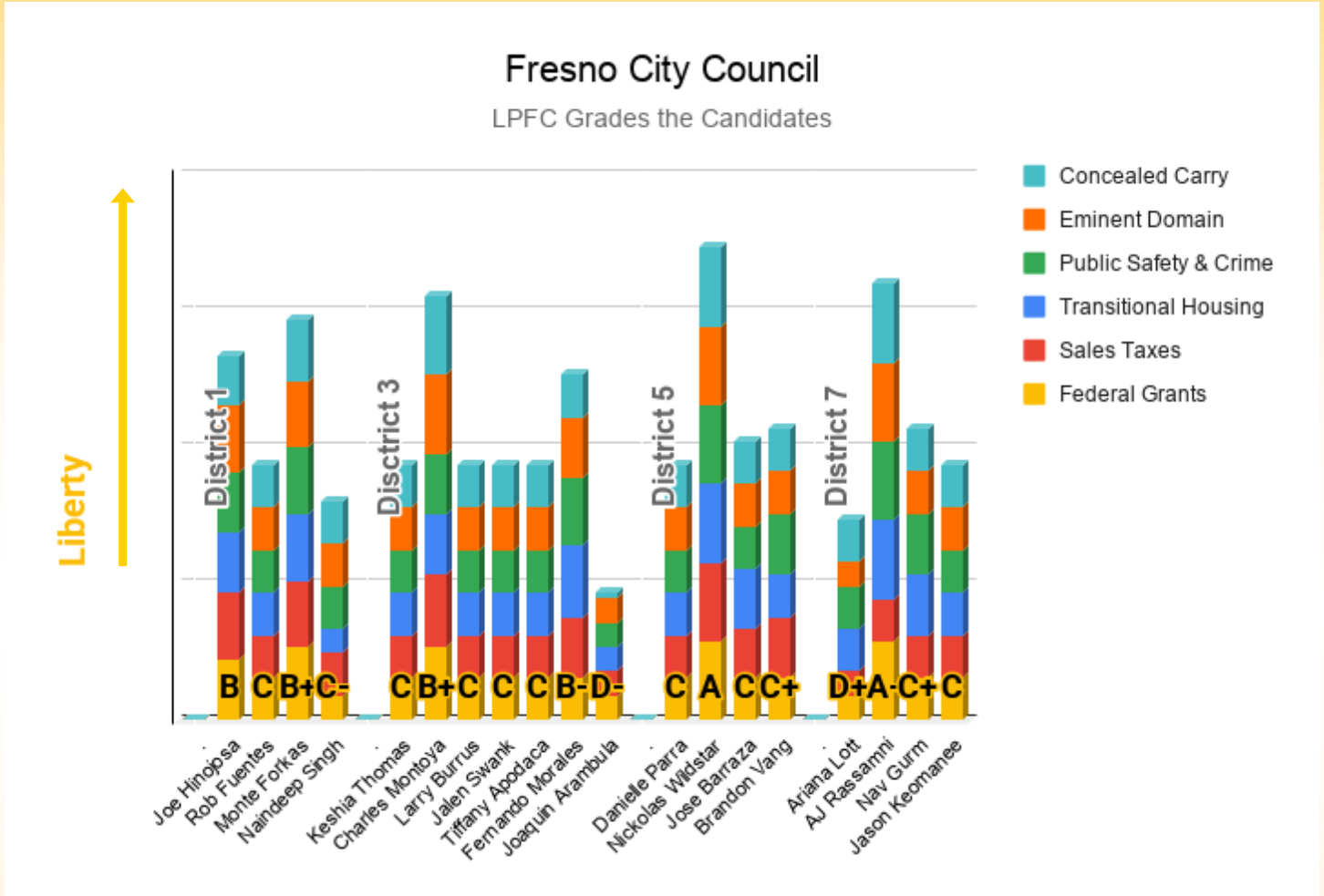
METHODOLOGY

Candidates were contacted with a set of questions:

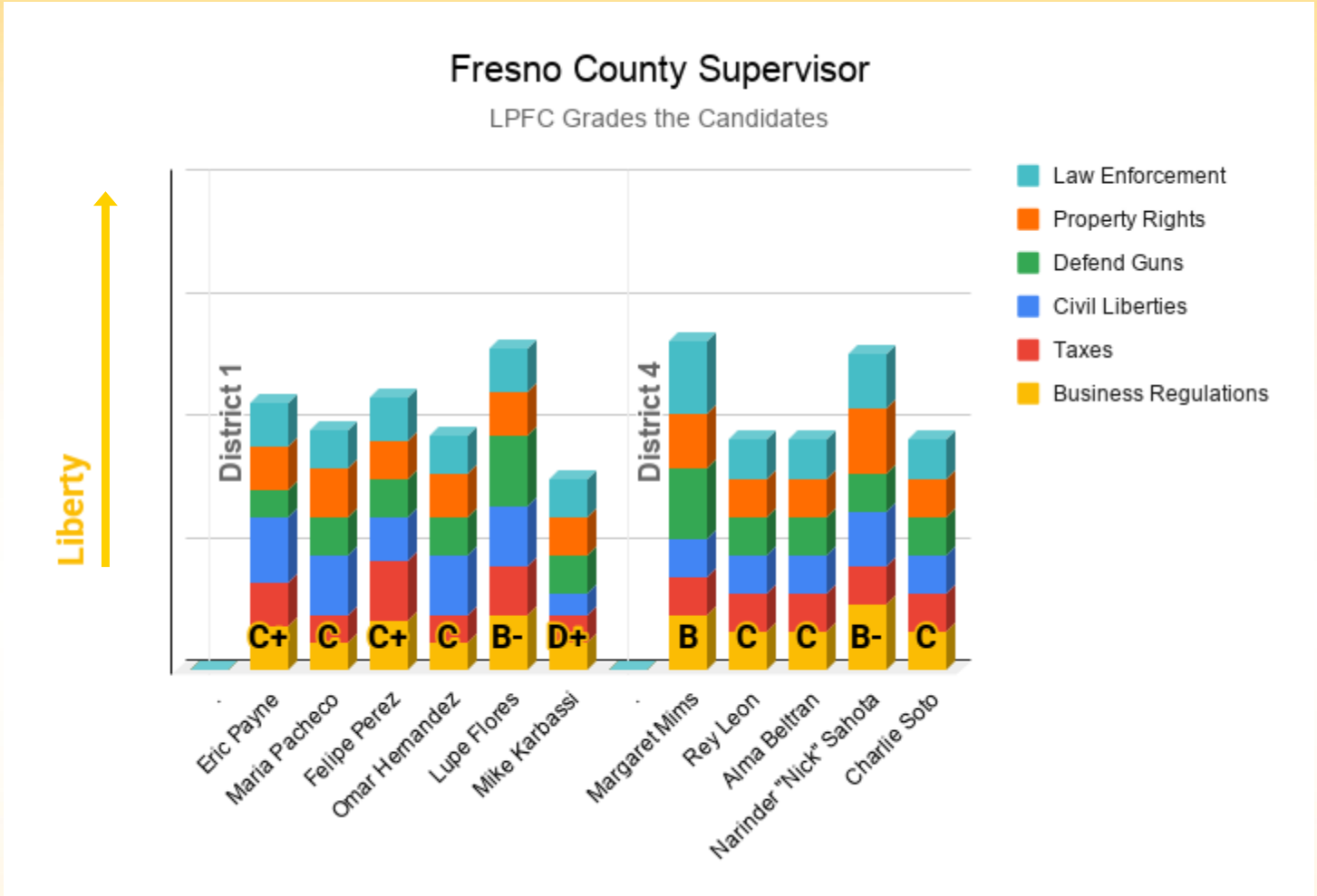
- Those who responded were graded primarily based on their answers

- **District 1:** Monte Forkas has a slight lead over Joe Hinojosa. Information on the other candidates was limited, but comparatively unfavorable
- **District 3:** Charles Montoya has a slight lead on Fernando Morales. Joaquin Arambula’s dismal record puts him at the bottom of the pack
- **District 5:** Nickolas Wildstar is our preferred candidate
- **District 7:** AJ Rassamni’s responses were aligned with libertarian values, while Ariana Lott’s record puts her at the bottom of the pack

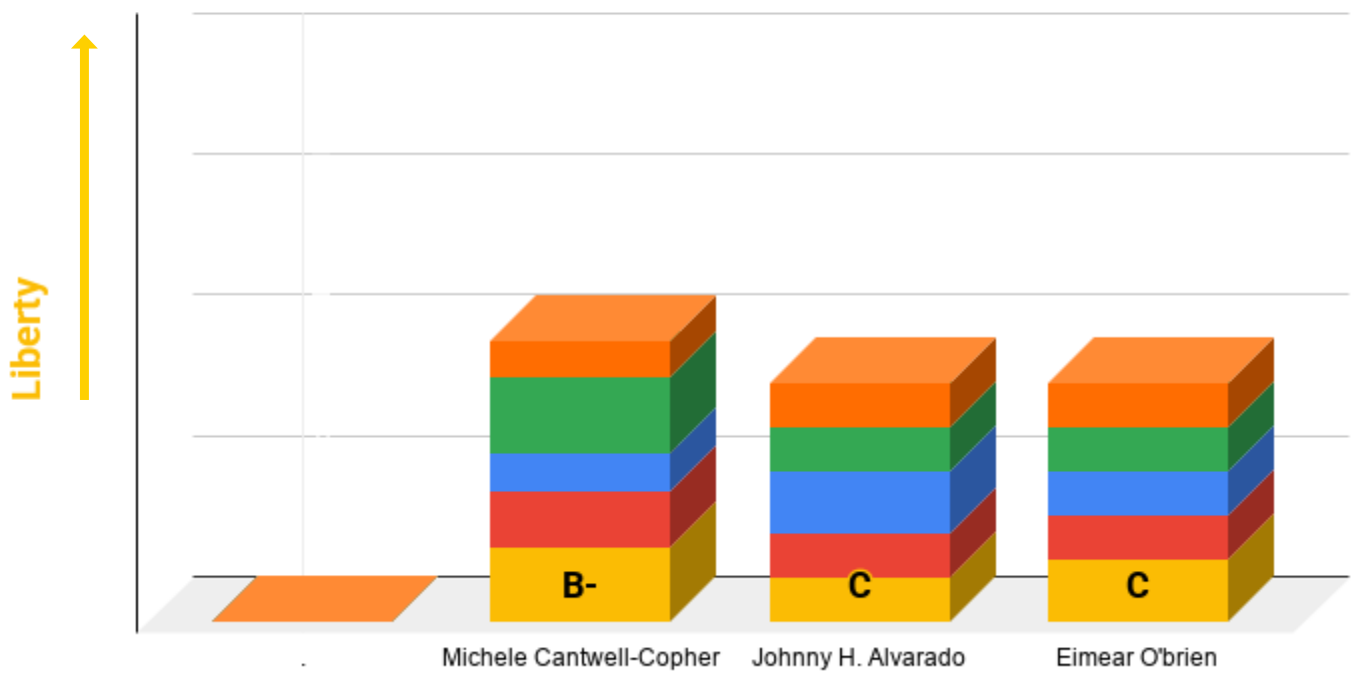


- **District 1:** Slight preference for Lupe Flores

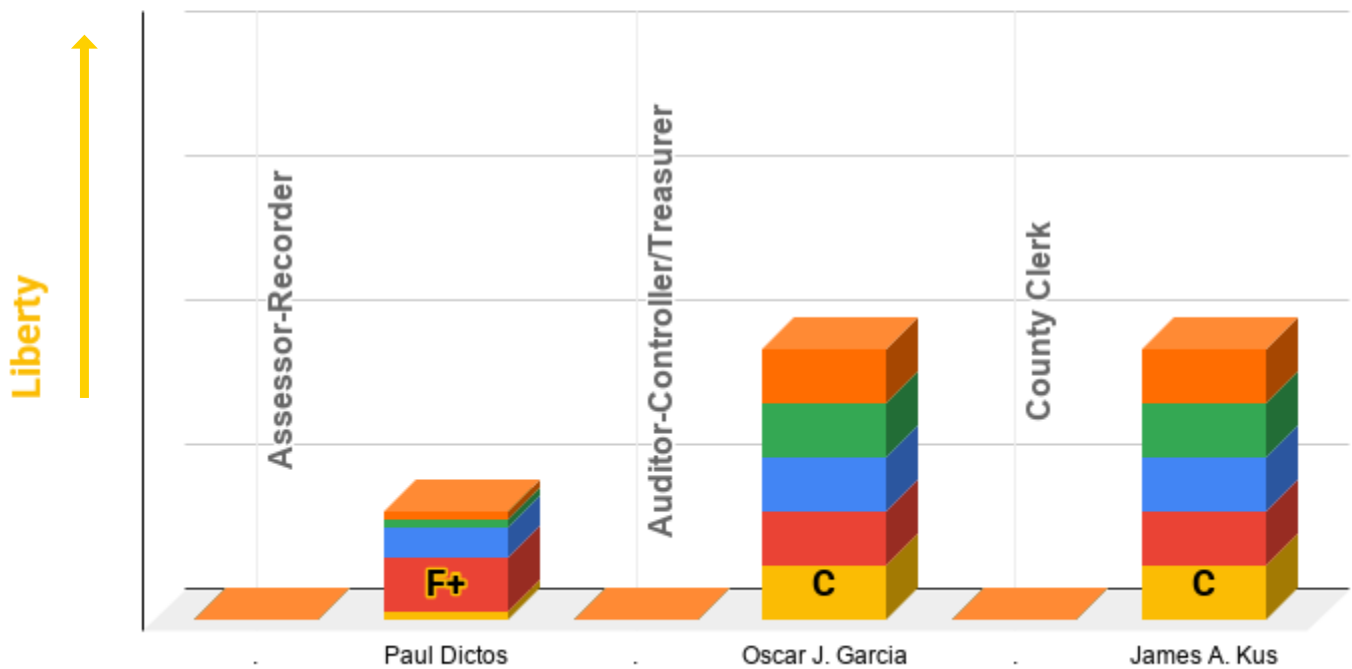

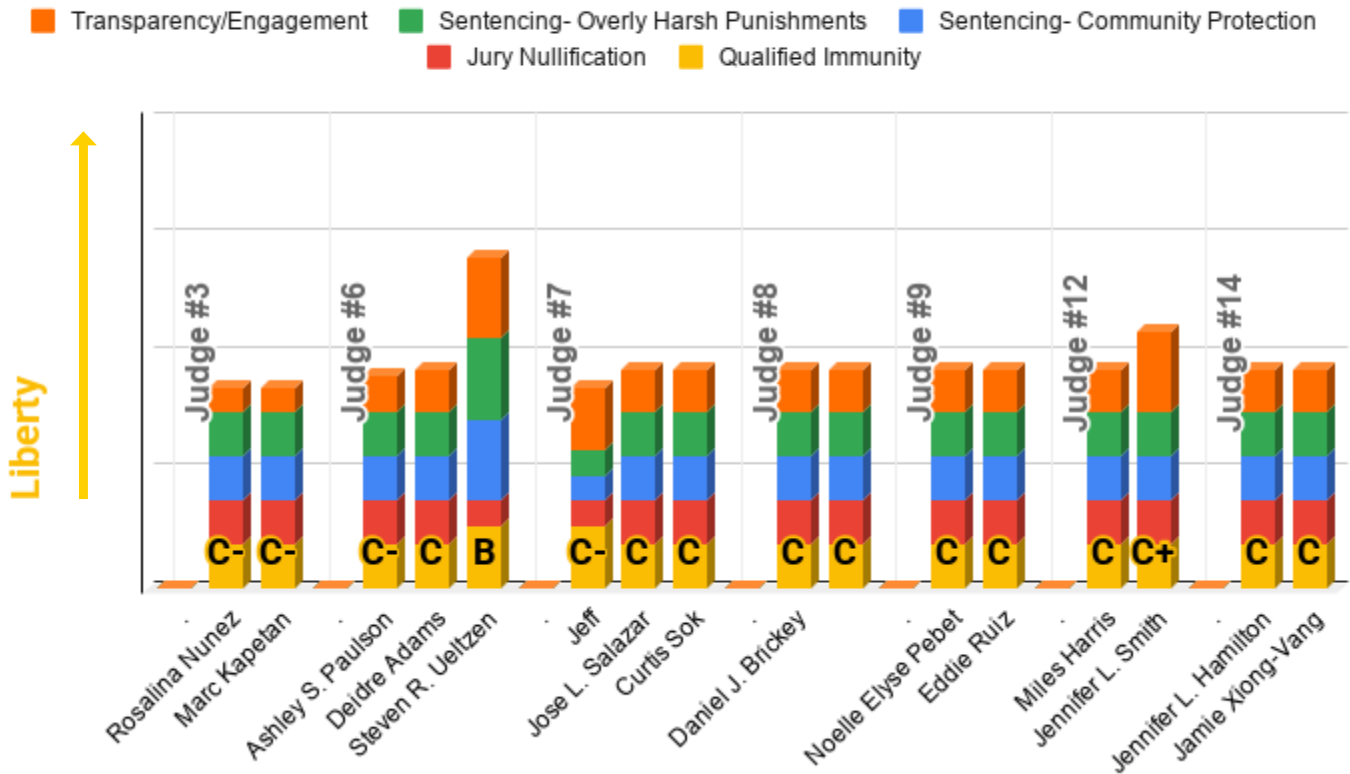
➤ **LPFC Recommendation:** Undervoting

An undervote occurs when the number of choices selected by a voter in an election is less than the maximum number allowed for that election.
